

ACTION OPPORTUNITY FOR TOWN OF POUGHKEEPSIE

CONGREGATIONS AND RESIDENTS

The Town of Poughkeepsie Climate Smart Task Force has launched a **Solar for All** Campaign in partnership with Cornell Cooperative Extension. This is an effort to assist income-eligible homeowners and renters in signing up for the state's Solar for All program to help reduce their energy bill burden.

Solar for All is a utility bill assistance program administered by the New York State Energy Research and Development Authority (NYSERDA) that offers lower-income households the opportunity to subscribe to a community solar project in their area without paying any costs or fees. By signing up for the Solar for All program, residents can receive a \$5 - \$15 monthly reduction on their electric bill while taking an important sustainability action that does not require any equipment to be installed on a house or apartment.
